MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Full Membership

“Full Members” are recognised as members of The Living Tree registered charity (TLT), having voting rights according to the Charities Act, General Regulations. This category of membership is open to those who wish to participate in the governance of TLT by registering for the right to appoint Trustees and to vote at Annual General meetings. This category of membership of TLT is open to anyone who is interested in furthering TLT “s purposes and has indicated his or her acceptance of the Duty of Members. The Duty of Members being the duty to exercise his or her powers as a member of TLT in the way he or she decides in good faith would be most likely to further the purposes of TLT. Members may participate in any or all TLT activities. Members’ names, addresses and contact details will be kept in a register of members. Membership is open ended. The onus is on all members to advise TLT if they no longer wish to remain a member.

Associate membership

“Associate membership” is the category of informal (non-voting) membership. This is a category for those whom TLT charity supports through the provision of therapy and activities but who do not wish to register as members. Associate members have no obligations towards TLT and are not obliged to contribute to it. Associate members are not recognised as legal members by the Charities Act, General Regulations therefore associate members are not included in the register of members nor may they vote at Annual General meetings. For administrative control and insurance purposes, limited personal contact details are requested from associate members. More detailed information may be necessary to check eligibility for certain benefits.

Trustees have the discretion to bar or to cancel any form of membership, but any such action is subject to a right of appeal.
